4	WHEREAS, the Union Parish High School Farmers had a remarkable football team
5	during the 2013 season with a 13-1 record on the way to winning a nail-biting championship
6	game in the Mercedes Benz Superdome; and
7	WHEREAS, the Union Parish Farmers and the Livonia Wildcats played with great
8	passion during the title game, exchanging the lead half-a-dozen times before entering the
9	first overtime period in a 20-20 tie score; and
10	WHEREAS, both teams refused to give up after regulation play and each scored
11	touchdowns in the first overtime period, forcing a second overtime period where the Union
12	Parish Farmers would score to win the game; and
13	WHEREAS, the Class 3A Championship was the first for Union Parish at that level
14	of play since the 2002 season when the Farmers captured the Class 2A title; and
15	WHEREAS, Union Parish also made high school football history when they played
16	a senior defensive back named Jacy Barron, the first time a girl has ever played in a state
17	football championship game at the Mercedes-Benz Superdome; and
18	WHEREAS, it was no small coincidence that the total number of points scored by

Union Parish in the championship was 33, the same number that fallen teammate Jaleel Gipson had worn before he tragically passed away and the same number that Union Parish Football Coach Joe Spatafora had predicted as a final score before the game was played.
