1	AN ACT
2	To repeal R.S. 37:3415.21(B), relative to the Louisiana Real Estate Appraisers Board; to
3	repeal certain provisions relative to legislative review of administrative rules
4	proposed by the board; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 37:3415.21(B) is hereby repealed.
7	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
8	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
9	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
10	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
1	effective on the day following such approval.

DIGEST

Martiny (SB 575)

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the La. Real Estate Appraisers Board (board) to adopt any rules and regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act that are necessary to enforce the provisions of <u>present law</u>.

Page 1 of 2 Coding: Words which are struck through are deletions from existing law; words <u>in boldface type and underscored</u> are additions. Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> requires affirmative approval of the proposed rules by the House of Representatives Committee on Commerce and the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs.

Proposed law repeals present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides that if the legislature is not in session, the proposed rules shall be deemed affirmatively approved if 45 days have elapsed from the date the proposed rules are received by the oversight committees and no hearing is held by either committee.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
