HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 101

FISHING/COMMERCIAL: Affirms support and appreciation for the Gulf menhaden fishery

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To express and affirm the support and appreciation of the House of Representatives of the
3 Legislature of Louisiana for the Gulf menhaden fishery and all of the economic and
4 social contributions that industry has made to the state through many years of
5 operation in the Gulf of Mexico and onshore in the coastal areas of the state.

6 WHEREAS the Gulf menhaden fishery industry generates an annual economic
7 impact of nearly eight hundred twenty-five million dollars to the economy of the state of
8 Louisiana; and

9 WHEREAS the Gulf menhaden fishery industry expends in excess of eighty million
10 dollars annually in purchases for materials and supplies from industry support vendors with
11 nearly sixty-five percent of those purchases made from other Louisiana businesses; and

12 WHEREAS the Gulf menhaden fishery industry provides over seven hundred
13 twenty-five jobs to citizens of the state of Louisiana with the salaries paid to those people
14 directly enhancing the economy of the state; and

15 WHEREAS the Gulf menhaden fishery industry indirectly creates and supports many
16 other good, high paying jobs throughout the state of Louisiana; and

17 WHEREAS the Gulf menhaden fishery is the largest fishery by volume in both the
18 state of Louisiana and the entire Gulf of Mexico; and

19 WHEREAS the Gulf States Marine Fisheries Commission declared in 2013 through
20 its SouthEast Data, Assessment, and Review (SEDAR 32A) report that "the Gulf Menhaden
21 stock in the Gulf of Mexico is not undergoing overfishing and is not overfished"; and

1 WHEREAS independent data has shown clear trends of increasing biomass and
2 recruitment along with declining mortality in the Gulf menhaden stock over the last twenty
3 years; and

4 WHEREAS the recent stock assessment of Gulf menhaden found in the Gulf of
5 Mexico demonstrates that the fishery is being harvested and managed at a sustainable level
6 and will continue to employ Louisianians and contribute to the economy and well-being of
7 the state for many years to come.

8 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
9 Legislature of Louisiana, that based on the fishery science established by the Gulf States
10 Marine Fisheries Commission, as a result of the responsible harvesting conducted by the
11 fishing community, the Gulf menhaden industry is and will continue to be of great value to
12 our state, occupy a key role in job creation, and provide substantial positive economic effect
13 on our region.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature
15 of Louisiana does hereby express and affirm the support and appreciation for the Gulf
16 menhaden fishery and all of the economic and social contributions that industry has made
17 to the state through many years of operation in the Gulf of Mexico and onshore in the coastal
18 areas of the state.
