DIGEST

Peacock (SB 353)

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts records and personal information of members of a petit jury venire and individuals serving on a jury from the Public Records Law.

<u>Proposed law</u> does not prohibit dissemination of jury questionnaires to attorneys licensed in this state or the dissemination of venire lists as required in <u>present law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2014.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental</u> <u>Affairs to the original bill</u>

1. Provides that proposed law does not prohibit the dissemination of jury questionnaires to counsel for parties in a case or the dissemination of venire lists as required by the Code of Criminal Procedure Art. 417.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

- 1. Makes <u>proposed law</u> applicable to members of a petit jury venire only.
- 2. Provides for dissemination of jury questionnaires to any attorney licensed in this state.
