2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:206, relative to the crime of fire prevention interference; to
3	add elements to the crime; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 14:206 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
6	§206. Fire prevention interference; penalty
7	A. Fire prevention interference is the intentional performance of any of the
8	following acts:
9	(1) Defacing or destroying fire warning notices or posters.
10	(2) Injuring, destroying, removing or in any manner interfering with the use
11	of any tools, equipment, towers, buildings, or telephone lines, or life safety systems
12	and equipment as defined in R.S. 40:1646(C), used in the detection, reporting or
13	suppression of fire.
14	(3) Obstructing exits, impeding egress, or exceeding the capacity or posted
15	occupant load of a building or structure.
16	(4) Unauthorized use or proximate display as defined in R.S. 51:650(9), of
17	fireworks in a building or structure.
18	<u>B.</u> Whoever commits the crime of fire prevention interference shall be fined
19	not more than five hundred dollars or imprisoned for a period of not more than six
20	months, or both.
