1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 47:463.165, relative to motor vehicle special prestige license plates; to provide
3	for the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation special prestige plate; to provide for
4	the creation, issuance, and design of such license plates; to provide relative to the fee
5	and distribution of fees for such plates; to authorize the promulgation of rules and
6	regulations relative to the creation and implementation of a special prestige license
7	plate; and to provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 47:463.165 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§463.165. Special prestige license plate; Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation
11	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
12	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the Juvenile
13	Diabetes Research Foundation, or "JDRF" plate, provided there is a minimum of one
14	thousand applicants for such plate. These license plates shall be restricted to use on
15	passenger cars, pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, and vans.
16	B. The license plate color and design shall be selected by the Louisiana
17	Chapter of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation, provided it is in compliance
18	with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the letters "JDRF".
19	C. The prestige plate shall be issued, upon application, to any citizen of
20	Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
21	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of thirty dollars, which
22	shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This fee shall be

1	in addition to the standard motor	vehicle license tax imposed by Article VII, Section
2	5 of the Constitution of Louisian	a, and a handling fee of three dollars and fifty cents

5	E. The annual royalty fe	e collected by the department shall be forwarded to
6	the Louisiana Chapter of the Juve	nile Diabetes Research Foundation, or its successor
7	organization. The monies received	ved from the royalty fees shall be used to improve
8	the lives of all people affected b	y Type 1 Diabetes by accelerating progress on the
9	most promising opportunities f	or curing, better treating, and preventing Type 1
10	Diabetes.	
11	F. The secretary shall pr	omulgate rules and regulations as are necessary to
12	implement the provisions in this	Section.
