CULTURE/REC/TOUR: Removes provisions relative to the exhibit of a specific ship by the Kenner Naval Museum

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Technical amendments only.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides with respect to the Kenner Naval Museum and the Kenner Naval Museum Commission. Also provides with respect to certain duties of the commission as well as its authority to acquire, lease, construct, and finance certain facilities and improvements.

<u>Present law</u> provides that part of the museum is the U.S.S. Cabot-Dedalo. Further provides that the duties of the commission include the management and maintenance of the U.S.S. Cabot-Dedalo. Also provides that the commission has the authority to acquire, lease, construct, and finance certain facilities and improvements with respect to the U.S.S. Cabot-Dedalo. <u>Proposed law</u> removes references to the U.S.S. Cabot-Dedalo but retains <u>present law</u> applicable to any naval vessel the commission acquires.
