RE1 NO IMPACT See Note

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Ensures compliance with requirements for mandatory workers' compensation coverage. (8/1/14)

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that workers' compensation insurer shall file notice of coverage no later than 30 days after effective date of coverage with the National Council on Compensation Insurance instead of the Louisiana Workforce Commission (LWC), Office of Workers' Compensation. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that any penalties for failure to secure workers' compensation shall be liable for a civil penalty assessed by a workers' compensation judge instead of LWC. <u>Proposed law</u> provides for a civil penalty assessed by a workers' compensation judge if any employer fails to provide proof of compliance within 15 days of any notice. In addition to civil penalties, <u>proposed law</u> provides that the employer must provide proof of coverage within 45 days. <u>Proposed law</u> provides any appeal may be made in the appropriate circuit court of appeal. If an employer is being investigated for failure to provide coverage, employer must show proof of coverage within 15 days or the LWC can set the matter for hearing with the workers' compensation judge. Proposed law if effective 08/01/2014.
