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Exempts Mandeville from certain laws regarding wages and hours of police officers

**Purpose of Bill:** This bill excludes the City of Mandeville from the provisions of R.S. 33:2211 - R.S. 33:2217, which provides for certain employment terms for police department employees, including sick leave and overtime pay. The provisions of the bill will be given retroactive and prospective effect.
