1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 33:2572, relative to the city of Plaquemine; to provide relative to the police
3	civil service; to provide that the position of assistant chief of police for the city of
4	Plaquemine shall be in the unclassified service; and to provide for related matters.
5	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6	as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
7	Louisiana.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 33:2572 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	<u>§2572. Assistant chief of police in the city of Plaquemine</u>
11	A. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the position of
12	assistant chief of police in the city of Plaquemine is in the unclassified service. The
13	right of selection, appointment, supervision, and discharge for the position shall be
14	vested in the chief of police of the city.
15	B. Any person who is appointed from a position in the classified police
16	service to serve as assistant chief of police shall not forfeit his seniority accumulated
17	to the date of his appointment and shall continue to accumulate seniority during the
18	time he holds the position of assistant chief of police.
19	C. If any such person resigns from the position of assistant chief of police
20	or is terminated for any reason other than malfeasance in office, he shall be eligible
21	to be reemployed to the same position in the classified service in which he was
22	employed immediately preceding his appointment as assistant chief of police. If the
