The purposes of the data bank shall be to improve health care quality and 19 to promote and protect patient safety. 20 C.(1) The board shall establish the data bank as a resource for the public on 21 its Internet website. 22 (2) The board shall publish in an easily accessible format in the data bank 23 information including, without limitation, all of the following: 24 (a) A listing of all optometrists licensed by the board who possess the training and credentials necessary to perform ophthalmic surgery. 25 26 (b) All of the following information concerning each optometrist required 27 by Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph to be listed in the data bank: 28 (i) Adverse licensure actions, if any. 29 (ii) Adverse clinical privileges actions, if any. (iii) Exclusions, if any, from Medicare, Medicaid, or other federal health care 30 31 programs. 32 (iv) Exclusions, if any, from any state health care program. 33 (v) Negative actions or findings by peer review organizations, if any. 34 (vi) Healthcare-related civil judgments in state court, if any.

(vii) Healthcare-related criminal convictions in state court, if any. D. The board may utilize as a template for the design and functionality of the data bank the National Practitioner Data Bank published online by the Health Resources and Services Administration of the United States Department of Health and Human Services."
