6	death of J. Harold Marchand, age sixty-two, of Gonzales, Louisiana, who passed away on
7	March 18, 2014; and
8	WHEREAS, Mr. Marchand was a devoted father to David and Micah Marchand,
9	loving grandfather to his four grandchildren, beloved fiancé, treasured sibling to his eleven
10	brothers and sisters, and friend to many; and
11	WHEREAS, Mr. Marchand was a talented athlete and former defensive tackle for
12	the LSU Fighting Tiger football team, the first signee from East Ascension High School; and
13	WHEREAS, Mr. Marchand was only the second parish president of Ascension Parish
14	and in that capacity was responsible for implementing the first road-widening plan for roads
15	in the parish and was instrumental in the creation of the award-winning finance department
16	for the parish of Ascension; and
17	WHEREAS, Mr. Marchand cared deeply for the youth of his parish and organized
18	the first Ascension Parish Youth Council, a service organization of local teens; and

1	WHEREAS, Mr. Marchand created the first parish government website and
2	streamlined parish constituent services to better serve the people of Ascension Parish; and
3	WHEREAS, Mr. Marchand instituted the Ascension 2020 program, a series of
4	parish-wide public meetings to allow constituents of Ascension Parish to participate in the
5	growth and development of the parish; and
6	WHEREAS, Mr. Marchand was involved in every step of the construction of the
7	Magnolia Business Center building in St. Rose and the Quixote Studios; and
8	WHEREAS, Mr. Marchand left an indelible impact on Ascension Parish through his
9	many years of service as parish president, sheriff's deputy, justice of the peace, and local
10	business owner.
11	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
12	express genuine sorrow upon the death of Mr. J. Harold Marchand and does hereby extend
13	sincere condolences to his family, friends, and community as they mourn his passing.
