4	WHEREAS, it is with deep regret and profound sorrow that the citizens of Louisiana
5	learned of the death of Jerry F. Meaux on Thursday, April 24, 2014, at the age of seventy-
6	four; and
7	WHEREAS, Jerry F. Meaux was appointed to serve on the Louisiana Racing
8	Commission by Governor Foster in 1996 and served as a member through 2004; and
9	WHEREAS, in 2008, he was appointed as the chairman of the Louisiana Racing
10	Commission by Governor Jindal and served in that capacity until his passing; and
11	WHEREAS, Mr. Meaux received his first horse trainer's license in the early 1960s,
12	trained quarter horses, and participated in quarter horse races throughout Louisiana, Texas,
13	and New Mexico; and
14	WHEREAS, by the early 1970s, he transitioned into training thoroughbreds and
15	predominantly raced throughout Louisiana; and
16	WHEREAS, in addition to training horses, Mr. Meaux was a longtime breeder and
17	owner, and was instrumental in launching horse racing at Evangeline Downs in Opelousas;

1	WHEREAS, Mr. Meaux was also involved in raising cattle and growing rice, and
2	was the chairman of the South Louisiana Electrical Membership Cooperative for twenty-two
3	years; and
4	WHEREAS, he served on the board of the Acadiana District Livestock Show and
5	sponsored 4-H and Future Farmers of America clubs in his community; and
6	WHEREAS, Mr. Meaux is survived by his loving wife of fifty-two years, Betty; five
7	children, Steven B. Meaux, Michelle M. Breaux, William B. Meaux, Johnny B. Meaux, and
8	Tommy B. Meaux; five grandchildren, Jamie M. McDaniel, Morgan M. Louviere, Brennan
9	J. Breaux, Avery M. Breaux, and Sydney R. Meaux; and two great-grandchildren, Alex M.
10	McDaniel and Lily C. McDaniel; and
11	WHEREAS, he was a gentleman who was admired by all whose lives he touched,
12	leaves behind a rich and unique legacy, and is greatly missed; and
13	WHEREAS, although the death of Jerry F. Meaux has left a tremendous void in his
14	community, his memory shall live forever in the minds and hearts of all who knew and loved
15	him.
