(2) As part of the Louisiana Taylor Opportunity Program for Students, for students graduating from high school through the 1999-2000 school year the state shall award an amount determined by the administering agency to equal the actual cost of tuition of any student who enrolls on a full-time basis in a Louisiana public postsecondary institution to pursue skill or occupational training, including a vocational or technical education certificate or diploma program or, a nonacademic undergraduate degree, or an occupationally-related two-year academic associate <u>degree program</u> and who meets the following qualifications and all other applicable qualifications of this Chapter and for students graduating from high school during the 2000-2001 school year and thereafter the state shall award an amount determined by the administering agency in accordance with the provisions of Subparagraph (f) of this Paragraph for any student who enrolls on a full-time basis in an eligible college or university as defined in Subsection A of this Section to pursue skill or occupational training as defined by the Board of Regents, including a vocational or technical education certificate or diploma program or a nonacademic undergraduate degree, and who meets the following qualifications and all other applicable qualifications of this Chapter:
