Requires the commissioner of administration to develop policies and procedures for notification of the Louisiana Procurement Technical Assistance Center regarding public bid and other competitive opportunities for state procurements and public

Proposed legislation requires the commissioner to publish policies and procedures to establish the method by which chief procurement officers and the director of the contractual review shall notify the LA Procurement Technical Assistance Center in Lafayette, the Northwest LA Procurement Technical Assistance Center in Shreveport and all LA Procurement Technical Assistance Centers located across the state which are nonprofit organizations established to assist small businesses in competing for government contracts.
