EVIDENCE. Provides relative to expert testimony

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> authorizes a witness qualified as an expert to testify if his specialized knowledge will assist the trier of fact to understand the evidence or determine a fact in issue.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and codifies existing jurisprudence requiring an expert's opinion to have a reliable basis.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no change in law or result in a ruling on evidence admissibility shall be presumed or is intended by the Legislature of Louisiana by the passage of <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary A to the engrossed bill</u>

- 1. Removes the phrase "all of the following apply".
- 2. Adds a new section with language providing that no change in law or result in a ruling on evidence admissibility shall be presumed or is intended by the Legislature of Louisiana by the passage of the proposed Act.
