

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 272 by Senator Murray

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 3 and 4,
3 and at the beginning of line 5, delete "42:1124(B)(3)," and insert the following:

4 "R.S. 18:1491.7(D), 1495.5(D), and 1511.3(A), to enact R.S. 42:1134(A)(3),
5 and to repeal R.S. 18:1511.2(A)(5),"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 1, delete lines 10 through 17 and delete pages 2 through 4, and insert the following:

8 "Section 1. R.S. 18:1491.7(D), 1495.5(D), and 1511.3(A) are hereby
9 amended and reenacted to read as follows:

10 §1491.7. Reports; contents

12 D. The supervisory committee, ~~by rule,~~ may require the reporting of totals
13 of any information otherwise required to be reported, including totals of amounts
14 reported in the current report, or in the current report and other previous reports.

22 §1511.3. Filing of reports; forms; notice

23 A.(1) All reports required by this Chapter shall be filed with the supervisory
24 committee as otherwise provided in this Chapter on forms provided by the
25 supervisory committee. The supervisory committee shall prepare forms for all
26 reports required by this Chapter in conformity with the requirements of this Chapter
27 and shall cause such forms to be printed and sufficient copies thereof furnished to
28 the clerks of court and in Orleans Parish to the clerk of the criminal district court,
29 who shall make them available to all persons required to file reports under the
30 provisions of this Chapter. All forms shall contain instructions directing the person
31 filing with whom to file reports. It is the intent of the legislature that the supervisory
32 committee shall provide forms in a simple format in conformity with the
33 requirements of this Chapter.

34 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 42:1134(A)(1) or the
35 Administrative Procedure Act, all forms required by this Chapter and all instructions
36 and explanation for the completion of such forms prepared by the supervisory

1 committee shall be submitted to the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental
2 Affairs and the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs for review
3 and approval. The approval of each legislative committee shall be required prior to
4 the utilization of a form or related instructions or explanation pursuant to this
5 Chapter. Upon receipt of a proposed form, instructions, or explanation, the
6 legislative committees shall meet, either separately or jointly, within sixty days to
7 consider and act on the proposed form, instructions, or explanation. Approval by
8 either legislative committee, meeting separately, shall require a favorable vote of a
9 majority of the members present and voting, a quorum of the legislative committee
10 being present. Approval by the two legislative committees, meeting jointly, shall
11 require a favorable vote of a majority of the members of each legislative committee
12 present and voting, each house voting separately, a quorum of the joint legislative
13 committee being present. If the proposed form, instructions, or explanation fails to
14 receive the approval of both legislative committees within sixty days after
15 submission by the supervisory committee, the proposed form, instructions, or
16 explanation shall be withdrawn from consideration.

18 Section 2. R.S. 42:1134(A)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

19 §1134. Powers, duties, and responsibilities of the board

22 (3) Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection or the
23 Administrative Procedure Act, all forms required by R.S. 42:1124, 1124.2, 1124.2.1,
24 1124.3, and 1124.5 shall be prepared and prescribed by the Board of Ethics as
25 provided in this Paragraph. The board shall submit all such proposed forms to the
26 Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs and the House Committee
27 on House and Governmental Affairs for review and approval. The approval of each
28 legislative committee shall be required prior to the utilization of a form to satisfy the
29 requirements of R.S. 42:1124, 1124.2, 1124.2.1, 1124.3, or 1124.5. Upon receipt of
30 a proposed form, the legislative committees shall meet, either separately or jointly,
31 within sixty days to consider and act on the proposed form. Approval by either
32 legislative committee, meeting separately, shall require a favorable vote of a majority
33 of the members present and voting, a quorum of the legislative committee being
34 present. Approval by the two legislative committees, meeting jointly, shall require
35 a favorable vote of a majority of the members of each legislative committee present
36 and voting, each committee voting separately, a quorum of the joint legislative
37 committee being present. If the proposed form fails to receive the approval of both
38 legislative committees within sixty days after submission by the supervisory
39 committee, the proposed form shall be withdrawn from consideration.

41 Section 3. R.S. 42:1511.2(A)(5) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

42 Section 4. All forms, instructions, and explanations promulgated or
43 prescribed by the Board of Ethics or the Supervisory Committee on Campaign
44 Finance Disclosure prior to the effective of this Act shall remain in effect until the
45 Board of Ethics or the Supervisory Committee on Campaign Finance Disclosure
46 prepares or prescribes new forms, instructions, or explanations and such forms,
47 instructions, and explanations receive approval in accordance with the provisions of
48 this Act."
