Art. 185), when he marries the mother of the<br>child and acknowledges the child by authentic act or by signing the birth certificate<br>(C.C. Art. 195), when he acknowledges the child by authentic act or by signing the<br>birth certificate (C.C. Art. 196), by judgment of paternity (C.C. Art. 198), or by<br>adoption (C.C. Art. 199). Proof of a father's filiation in accordance with the Civil<br>Code, as provided in the 2014 revision to this Article, permits the filiated father's<br>relative to petition for intrafamily adoption but does not necessitate the father's<br>consent to adoption unless his consent is specifically required under Ch.C. Art. 1193. |
