3	registration of vehicles; to provide for required credentials for initial and first
4	renewal of registration of a motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer; to provide for
5	penalties for fraudulent execution of required credentials; and to provide for related

7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 47:501(C)(1) and (2) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
9	47:501(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§501. Owner to secure registration
11	* * *
12	C.(1) An individual applying for initial registration of a motor vehicle, trailer,
13	semitrailer, or other vehicle intended to be operated upon the public highways of this
14	state shall provide a current and valid photo identification which includes the owner's
15	full legal name and license number or identification card number issued in this state,
16	or another state, or by the United States military. An individual applying for initial
17	registration through the mail shall include a copy of a current and valid photo
18	identification which includes the owner's full legal name and license number or
19	identification card number issued in this state, or by the United
20	States military with his application. If the individual does not possess any of the
21	credentials specified in this Paragraph, the individual shall certify in writing
22	that he does not possess any of the credentials specified in this Paragraph on a
23	form approved by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections. Any
24	application which is not accompanied by a copy of the credential or the

2	the department after January 1, 2015. The individual's full legal name and the

4	(2) An individual applying for the first renewal of registration of a motor
5	vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or other vehicle intended to be operated upon the public
6	highways of this state shall provide a current and valid photo identification which

VETO MESSAGE

"Senate Bill No. 418 by Senator Gary Smith, which was introduced on behalf of the Department of Public Safety, was inadvertently drafted in a manner that jeopardizes the integrity of the Department of Public Safety's vehicle titling and registration database.

The legislation was intended to prohibit copying of military identification cards, which is consistent with federal law. Additionally, the legislation was intended to remove the requirement that valid photo identification be submitted with first-time renewals of vehicle registration. Due to drafting errors, the legislation would allow initial vehicle registration without the submission of valid photo identification.

For these reasons, and at the request of the Office of Motor Vehicle Commissioner Stephen Campbell, I have vetoed Senate Bill No. 418 and hereby return it to the Senate."
