

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 1258 by Representative Thibaut

MOTOR VEHICLES: Provides relative to motor vehicle inspection checkpoints

Synopsis of Senate Amendments	
1.	Made technical changes.
2.	Provided that the checkpoint cannot be less than 500 feet from an intersection between a state and federal highway.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law requires that all law enforcement agencies involved in traffic enforcement establish guidelines for the operation of seat belt checkpoints and proof of compulsory motor vehicle liability security checkpoints.

Proposed law adds motor vehicle inspection checkpoints to present law.

Present law provides that checkpoint guidelines include location, time, and duration, and they shall be established in written form by supervisory or administrative personnel rather than field officers. Proposed law provides that the location of a motor vehicle inspection checkpoint cannot be less than 500 feet from an intersection between a state and federal highway.
