2 To commend and congratulate Matthew Joseph Prilliman on his graduation from Teurlings
3 Catholic High School in Lafayette, Louisiana.

4 WHEREAS, Teurlings Catholic High School (TCHS) is a school of about six
5 hundred and fifty students that strives to embrace their students and to both nurture and
6 inspire the very best in each and every individual student; and

7 WHEREAS, this May, Matthew Joseph Prilliman has been named one of four
8 Monsignor Charles Fortier Honor Graduates from Teurlings Catholic High School; and

9 WHEREAS, the graduating class of 2014 will be recognized for their achievements
10 at the Honors Convocation on May 18, on campus and they will celebrate their
