1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To create a study committee to study and make recommendations with respect to the

3 implementation of the FDA Food Safety Modernization Act.

4 WHEREAS, approximately forty-eight million people, or one in six Americans, get

5 sick, one hundred twenty-eight thousand are hospitalized, and three thousand die each year

6 from foodborne diseases, according to recent data from the Centers for Disease Control and

7 Prevention; and

8 WHEREAS, this is a significant public health burden that is largely preventable; and

9 WHEREAS, Louisiana has a world-renowned culture known for its unique cuisine

10 and products and a deep commitment to safety and quality; and

11 WHEREAS, the passage of the FDA Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA)

12 created historic changes in food safety law on a national scale by authorizing increased

13 enforcement capability for the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA), creating

14 more accountability for farmers, and mandating enhanced partnerships between the FDA and

15 state and local regulatory authorities; and

16 WHEREAS, the FSMA builds a formal system of collaboration with other

17 government agencies, both domestic and foreign, in recognition that all food safety agencies

18 need to work together in an integrated way to achieve our public health goals.

19 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby

20 create a study committee, composed of members as hereinafter provided, to study and make

1 recommendations to the legislature with respect to the implementation of the FDA Food
2 Safety Modernization Act.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study committee shall be composed of the
4 following members:

5 (1) The assistant secretary of the office of public health of the Department of Health
6 and Hospitals or his designee.

7 (2) A representative from the sanitarian services division of the office of public
8 health of the Department of Health and Hospitals.

9 (3) The commissioner of agriculture or his designee.

10 (4) The president of the Louisiana Restaurant Association or his designee.

11 (5) The president of the Louisiana Association of Business and Industry or his
12 designee.

13 (6) The executive director of the Louisiana Retailers Association or his designee.

14 (7) The president of the Louisiana Oil Marketers and Convenience Store Association
15 or his designee.

16 (8) The president of the Louisiana Public Health Association or his designee.

17 (9) One member representing the Louisiana State University Agricultural Center.

18 (10) One member representing the Southern University Agricultural Center.

19 (11) One member of the House of Representatives appointed by the speaker of the
20 House of Representatives.

21 (12) One member of the Senate appointed by the president of the Senate.

22 (13) One member appointed by the chairman of the House Committee on Health and
23 Welfare.

24 (14) One member appointed by the chairman of the Senate Committee on Health and
25 Welfare.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that members of the study committee shall serve
27 without compensation.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the assistant secretary of the office of public
29 health of the Department of Health and Hospitals or his designee shall serve as chair of the

1 study committee and shall convene the first meeting of the committee no later than
2 September 1, 2014.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary of the Department of Health and
4 Hospitals shall designate staff of the department to assist the study committee in performing
5 its duties.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study committee shall meet as necessary and
7 shall report its findings to the legislature not later than January 30, 2015.
