2	To commend Evelyn Elain Ellerbe of Jackson, Louisiana, upon her receipt of a 2014
3	Women of Excellence Award from the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus
4	Foundation for her achievements in the field of Louisiana Hero of Excellence.
5	WHEREAS, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe has over thirty years of business administration
6	experience with an emphasis for the past twenty-five years in the field of human social
7	services for incarcerated populations and under-resourced families impacted by the criminal
8	justice system; and
9	WHEREAS, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe is chief executive officer of Refined by Fire
10	Ministries (RBF), Inc., a nonprofit organization that she and her family founded in 1995; and

12	WHEREAS, in 2009, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe received her National Consultant/Trainer
13	designation from Dr. Stephen Bavolek, creator of the evidence-based Nurturing Parenting
14	Program, and was also awarded the Innovator Instructor for Financial Management by VISA
15	International; and
16	WHEREAS, in 2010, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe was certified in the National Fatherhood
17	Initiative's 24/7 Dad and Inside/Out Dad curriculum; and

1	WHEREAS, additionally in 2010, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe received her lifetime
2	certification as a trainer and facilitator of Bridges Out of Poverty and the unique Solutions
3	to Poverty curriculum, Getting Ahead in A Just Getting By World; and
4	WHEREAS, in 2012, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe led Refined By Fire Ministries through
5	the process of being recognized as an Area Consultant agency for Bridges Out of Poverty,
6	a designation that includes the nine-parish area surrounding Metro Baton Rouge; and
7	WHEREAS, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe has also fostered several cutting edge programs
8	including: a Fatherhood Initiative in correctional facilities across Louisiana; an incarcerated
9	parent video project, Read to Me Daddy/Mommy; and a seven-year partnership with the
10	national retailer, Men's Wearhouse, for a statewide suit donation program for offenders
11	returning home; and
12	WHEREAS, in 2013, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe suffered the death of her husband,
13	Michael, who was director of Reentry at Dixon Correctional Institute, following his
14	courageous battle with cancer, and to whom she was married for over thirty-five years; and
15	WHEREAS, in July of 2013, both Michael and Elain were inducted into the
16	Louisiana Justice Hall of Fame with a Lifetime Achievement Recognition for their
17	outstanding work in the field of reentry in this state; and
18	WHEREAS, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe remains committed to continuing the work with
19	incarcerated and under-resourced populations that she and Michael were called to do so
20	many years ago; and
21	WHEREAS, just recently, in March of 2014, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe was selected by
22	the Louisiana State University Women's Center as one of its 2014 Esprit de Femme
23	recipients which honors outstanding women leaders across our state; and
24	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation created the
25	Women of Excellence Awards to recognize and honor extraordinary women of excellence
26	across the state for their outstanding achievements and contributions; and
27	WHEREAS, recipients of the Women of Excellence Awards exhibit characteristics
28	of integrity and professionalism, personify excellence in their area of specialty, and are
29	committed to community service to better society as a whole; and

1	WHEREAS, for 2014, there are six fields or categories for the Women of Excellence
2	Awards: Business, College Woman of Excellence, Education and Research, High School
3	Woman of Excellence, Louisiana Hero of Excellence, and Military; and
4	WHEREAS, the recipients of the 2014 Women of Excellence Awards are being
5	recognized at the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation's Women of
6	Excellence Awards and Scholarships Ceremony and Reception on Tuesday, May 27, 2014,
7	at the historic Hilton Capitol House Hotel in Baton Rouge; and
8	WHEREAS, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe of Jackson, Louisiana, has been named a recipient
9	of a 2014 Women of Excellence Award in the field of Louisiana Hero of Excellence, a field
10	which recognizes an ordinary everyday person who is making extraordinarily positive
11	differences in changing the lives of people in Louisiana and beyond; and
12	WHEREAS, Evelyn Elain Ellerbe merits a sincere and heartfelt measure of
13	commendation for her dedication to excellence and her outstanding accomplishments, and
14	it is entirely appropriate for the Legislature of Louisiana to commend Evelyn Elain Ellerbe
15	upon her receipt of a 2014 Women of Excellence Award from the Louisiana Legislative
16	Women's Caucus Foundation which recognizes her vital contributions to the citizens of
