5	WHEREAS, Clarissa A. Preston is a New Orleans native and a 1994 graduate of
6	Louisiana State University where she earned a bachelor of arts degree in sociology, and in
7	2012 she earned a master of business administration degree from the University of Phoenix,
8	Baton Rouge Campus; and
9	WHEREAS, Ms. Preston joined the Adams and Reese law firm in 2013 in the firm's
10	Baton Rouge office as a lobbyist and member of the Governmental Relations team, working
11	with state legislators, the executive branch, and state agencies, as well as other public policy
12	makers to protect and promote clients' interests; and
13	WHEREAS, Ms. Preston served as the head of the office of consumer advocacy for
14	the Louisiana Department of Insurance, where she was the first deputy commissioner
15	appointed to the position after its creation by the Louisiana Legislature in 2007; and
16	WHEREAS, in her seventeen years of experience in the field of insurance,
17	Ms. Preston worked as a regulator, an insurance company producer, and a consumer
18	advocate; she has both regulatory and industry-recognized insurance designations and is a
19	licensed multiline insurance producer, all of which more than qualify her as a regular

presenter to agents and companies on insurance issues and related topics and to
 organizations as part of community outreach, and as a teacher of continuing education
 courses; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Preston is an American Bar Association-approved certified
paralegal and commissioned civil law notary public and holds both property and casualty
and life and health insurance licenses; she also earned an Associate Professional in Insurance
Regulation (APIR) designation through the National Association of Insurance
Commissioners and holds a Certified Insurance Counselor (CIC) Designation from the
National Alliance for Insurance Education and Research; and

WHEREAS, among her other accomplishments, Ms. Preston serves as the Executive
Director of the Louisiana Surplus Line Association and in 2013 was elected to the Board of
the National African American Insurance Association; and

WHEREAS, another achievement for which Ms. Preston can be proud is that while working full time, she harnessed her personal passions and ventured into her own business, Montage Enterprises, LLC, a company that provides professional services in consulting, planning, marketing, training, and staging; her company's mission is encouraging and nurturing entrepreneurs, bringing undeveloped visions to reality, and cultivating continuing training; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Preston's involvement in the community includes holding
membership in several community service and professional organizations; she is a past
Lieutenant Governor of Division 8B of the Kiwanis International Louisiana-MississippiWest Tennessee District and serves as the Division 8B Coordinator for the Kiwanis
Worldwide ELIMINATE project; she is a member of the Kiwanis Club of South Baton
Rouge and the Louisiana Attorney Disciplinary Board hearing committee; and is a Reading
