WHEREAS, the Galvez Chapter is active at the state and national level and was a host of the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution state conference and sent several members to Washington, D.C., to participate in the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution Constitutional Congress.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the Galvez Chapter of the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution.
