HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 1089 by Representative Billiot

MTR VEHICLE/DEALERS: Provides with respect to insurance requirements for rental motor vehicle dealers

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Removes that the contingent automobile liability policy required to be maintained by motor vehicle rental dealers has to be placed through a La. licensed and admitted insurance company.
- 2. Provides that the required policy may be surplus lines insurance as defined by law rather than a policy from an approved nonadmitted insurer that is licensed by the state and has an A.M. Best rating of B+ or better.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> requires every rental dealer to maintain a contingent automobile liability policy of insurance with minimum limits of \$100,000 per occurrence, \$300,000 aggregate, and \$50,000 in property damage.

<u>Present law</u> requires rental dealers to purchase their policy of contingent automobile liability insurance through an insurer that is licensed by and admitted in the state.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes <u>present law</u> requirement and provides that such policy may be surplus lines insurance.

Proposed law provides for legislative findings and intent.
