1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 22:1827, relative to health insurance coverage; to prohibit a provider of
3	healthcare services from refusing to submit a claim to a health insurance issuer under
4	certain circumstances; to define certain terms; to provide that certain conflicting
5	provisions in agreements between a provider of healthcare services and a health
6	insurance issuer shall be deemed null and void; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 22:1827 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	<u>§1827.</u> Submission of health insurance claims
10	A. No healthcare provider that accepts a patient's health insurance coverage
11	shall require an enrollee or insured to consent to payment for healthcare services as
12	a condition for verification of health insurance coverage for such healthcare services.
13	B. For purposes of this Section:
14	(1) "Healthcare services" means services, items, supplies, or drugs for the
15	diagnosis, prevention, treatment, cure, or relief of a health condition, illness, injury,
16	or disease.
17	(2) "Health insurance coverage" means benefits consisting of medical care
18	provided or arranged for directly, through insurance or reimbursement, or otherwise,
19	and includes healthcare services paid for under any plan, policy, or certificate of
20	insurance.
21	(3) "Health insurance issuer" means any entity that offers health insurance
22	coverage through a policy or certificate of insurance subject to state law that
23	regulates the business of insurance. For purposes of this Subpart, a "health insurance
24	issuer" shall include a health maintenance organization, as defined and licensed
25	pursuant to Subpart I of Part I of Chapter 2 of this Title, nonfederal government

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1	plans subject to the provisions of Subpart B of this Part, and the Office of Group
2	Benefits.
3	C. Any provision in an agreement between a provider of healthcare services
4	and a health insurance issuer that conflicts with the provisions of this Section shall
5	be deemed null and void.
