5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. Civil Code Article 136(B) and (C) are hereby amended and reenacted to
7	read as follows:
8	Art. 136. Award of visitation rights
9	* * *
10	B. A grandparent not granted custody of a child may be granted reasonable
11	visitation rights if the court finds that it is in the best interest of the child. Before
12	making this determination, the court shall hold a contradictory hearing as provided
13	for in R.S. 9:345 in order to determine whether the court should appoint an attorney
14	to represent the child.
15	C. Under extraordinary circumstances, any other relative, by blood or
16	affinity, or a former stepparent or stepgrandparent, not granted custody of the child
17	may be granted reasonable visitation rights if the court finds that it is in the best
18	interest of the child. Extraordinary circumstances shall include a determination by
19	a court that a parent is abusing a controlled dangerous substance.
