1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 47:1923(D), relative to assessors; to provide relative to the
3	payment of certain group insurance premiums for retirees of certain assessors'
4	offices; to establish retiree eligibility criteria; and to provide for related matters.
5	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6	as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
7	Louisiana.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 47:1923(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§1923. Authority for assessors separately or jointly to contract for insurance;
11	payment of premiums

13	D.(1)(a) In the parishes of Allen, Ascension, Assumption, Avoyelles,
14	Beauregard, Bienville, Calcasieu, Caldwell, Cameron, Catahoula, Claiborne,
15	Concordia, DeSoto, East Baton Rouge, Franklin, Iberia, Iberville, Jackson, Jefferson,
16	Lafayette, Lafourche, LaSalle, Lincoln, Livingston, Madison, Morehouse,
17	Natchitoches, Orleans, Ouachita, Plaquemines, Pointe Coupee, Rapides, Red River,
18	Sabine, St. Bernard, St. Charles, St. Helena, St. John the Baptist, St. Landry, St.
19	Martin, Tangipahoa, Tensas, Terrebonne, Union, Vermilion, Vernon, Washington,
20	Webster, West Baton Rouge, West Carroll, and West Feliciana, the assessor shall
21	pay the premium cost of group life, dental, group health, hospital, surgical, or other
22	medical insurance for any assessor or assessor's employee who retires with at least
23	twenty years of service who is at least fifty-five years of age or who retires with at
24	least thirty years of service at any age meets the requirements of Subparagraph (b)

of this Paragraph. A uniform policy with respect to the payment of such premium shall be formulated and applied by the assessor of each parish listed in this Subsection Subparagraph.

(b) Either of the following requirements shall be met for eligibility for the

- (b) Either of the following requirements shall be met for eligibility for the assessor's payment of premium costs as provided in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph:
- (i) The assessor or assessor's employee was elected, appointed, or hired before August 1, 2014, and retires in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 11:1421 with at least twenty years of service.
- (ii) The assessor or assessor's employee was elected, appointed, or hired on or after August 1, 2014, and retires in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 11:1421 with at least twenty years of service. At least twelve years of service shall have been earned at the assessor's office from which the person retires. For purposes of this Item, the twelve years of service required for eligibility for receipt of benefits provided for in this Paragraph shall not include any service that was earned elsewhere and transferred for credit with the assessor's office from which the person retires.
- (2)(a) In Acadia Parish, the assessor shall pay the premium cost of group life, dental, group health, hospital, surgical, or other medical insurance for any assessor or assessor's employee who retires with at least twenty-five years of service who is at least fifty-five years of age or who retires with at least thirty years of service at any age meets the requirements of Subparagraph (b) of this Paragraph. A uniform policy with respect to the payment of the cost of such premium shall be formulated and applied by the assessor of Acadia Parish.
- (b) Either of the following requirements shall be met for eligibility for the assessor's payment of premium costs as provided in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph:
- (i) The assessor or assessor's employee was elected, appointed, or hired before August 1, 2014, and retires in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 11:1421 with at least twenty-five years of service.

1 (ii) The assessor or assessor's employee was elected, appointed, or hired on 2 or after August 1, 2014, and retires in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 3 11:1421 with at least twenty years of service. At least twelve years of service shall 4 have been earned at the Acadia Parish assessor's office. For purposes of this Item, the twelve years of service required for eligibility for receipt of benefits provided for 5 6 in this Paragraph shall not include any service that was earned elsewhere and 7 transferred for credit with the Acadia Parish assessor's office. 8 (3)(a) In the parishes of East Carroll and Richland, the assessor shall pay the 9 premium cost of group life, dental, group health, hospital, surgical, or other medical 10 insurance for any assessor or assessor's employee who meets the requirements of 11 Subparagraph (b) of this Paragraph. A uniform policy with respect to the payment 12 of the cost of such premium shall be formulated and applied by the assessor of each 13 parish listed in this Subparagraph. 14 (b) The requirements of this Subparagraph shall be met for eligibility for the 15 assessor's payment of premium costs as provided in Subparagraph (a) of this 16 Paragraph. The assessor or assessor's employee was elected, appointed, or hired on 17 or after August 1, 2014, and retires in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 18 11:1421 with at least twenty years of service. At least twelve years of service shall 19 have been earned at the assessor's office from which the person retires. For purposes 20 of this Item, the twelve years of service required for eligibility for receipt of benefits 21 provided for in this Paragraph shall not include any service that was earned 22 elsewhere and transferred for credit with the assessor's office from which the person 23 retires.
