

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 932 by Representative St. Germain

MOTOR VEHICLES: Provides for acts of donation of a motor vehicle without an authentic act

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Changed the requirement that the donation be documented by written act of the donor and donee to being documented by delivery of the vehicle's certificate of title executed by the donor-owner.
2. Made technical changes.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Proposed law provides that a donation of a titled movable by manual gift as provided by present law and documented by delivery of the motor vehicle's previously issued certificate of title that is executed by the donor-owner may be submitted to the office of motor vehicles in connection with a motor vehicle transaction by a La. Motor Vehicle Commission licensee.

Present law provides that the Motor Vehicle Commission is vested with the powers and duties necessary to enable it to carry out the provisions of present law, and the commission is authorized to make and enforce all reasonable rules and regulations to accomplish said purpose, and the enumeration of any power or authority herein shall not be construed to deny, impair, disparage, or limit any others necessary to the attainment thereof.

Proposed law adds a clarification to present law that specifies that the commission shall not make and enforce rules and regulations that limit or prohibit a dealer from making a monetary donation or contribution that does not directly involve the sale or lease of a motor vehicle in connection with an advertising campaign.
