1 WHEREAS, hailing from Notre Dame, Carney connected on a franchise record 82.8
2 percent of his field-goal attempts as a Saint, and his one hundred sixty-eight field goals
3 made, two hundred three attempts, and seven hundred sixty-eight points scored all rank
4 second in team history; and

5 WHEREAS, of the almost five hundred placement attempts in Carney's career as a
6 Saint, perhaps his most famous was the game-winning field goal in the 2005 season opener
7 against the Carolina Panthers, thirteen days after the region was ravaged by Hurricane
8 Katrina; and

9 WHEREAS, an image of Brooks congratulating Carney after his game-winning kick
10 graced the cover of the September 19, 2005, issue of *Sports Illustrated*; and

11 WHEREAS, both men have brought distinction and honor to the NFL and
12 specifically to the Saints; and

13 WHEREAS, Aaron Brooks and John Carney have been elected to the Saints Hall of
14 Fame for the Class of 2014.

15 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
16 congratulate Aaron Brooks and John Carney on their election to the New Orleans Saints Hall
17 of Fame and commends them on their outstanding careers and the contributions they have
18 made to the Saints, the city of New Orleans, and to the state of Louisiana.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this resolution be transmitted
20 to Mr. Aaron Brooks and Mr. John Carney.
