18	as defined by R.S. 49:214.2, or arising from or related to any use as
19	defined by R.S. 49:214.23(13), when all of the following conditions are
20	met:
21	(a) The plaintiff in such an action shall have the burden of proof
22	by clear and convincing evidence that a defendant has violated a
23	provision of law or a legal obligation.
24	(b) No attorney or law firm representing a plaintiff in such an
25	action shall receive as compensation or fees an amount greater than ten
26	percent of the monetary judgement or the settlement amount, whether
27	payable out of the proceeds of the settlement or directly from the
28	defendant.
29	(c) Any funds received by any plaintiff in such a suit as a
30	monetary judgment or settlement, less attorneys fees and costs, shall be
31	deposited in and credited to the Coastal Protection and Restoration
32	Fund to be used for the purposes provided for in the master plan for
33	integrated coastal protection.
34	(d) In the event a judgment dismissing a defendant from the
35	action is rendered for any reason, whether upon application by any
36	party or after trial, the defendant shall be entitled to recover from the

plaintiff all costs associated with defending such action including, without limitation, reasonable attorney fees.

(2) Each allegation or other factual assertion in any such suit shall have evidentiary support. A failure to have evidentiary support for each allegation or other factual assertion shall subject the party and its attorney to sanctions.

7 (3) It is the intent of the Legislature of Louisiana to authorize
8 those entities that have a cause of action pursuant to the provisions of
9 law enumerated in Paragraph (P)(1) of this Section to pursue those
10 causes of action provided the restrictions provided for in Paragraph
11 (P)(1) are met, and shall not create a new cause of action or right of
12 action for any party."
