3	for utility line work; to provide for applicability; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 37:1367(I) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	§1367. License required, journeyman and master plumber; medical gas piping
7	installer; medical gas and vacuum systems verifier; water supply protection
8	specialist endorsement; local examination preempted
9	* * *
10	I.(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Section, any person or firm who
11	is not licensed by the State Plumbing Board, but who is properly licensed for
12	municipal and public works utility construction pursuant to the requirements of the
13	State Licensing Board for Contractors, may perform main-line utility construction
14	on private property or undedicated rights-of-way or servitudes, limited to the
15	following:
16	(a) Gravity sanitary sewer collection lines six inches and larger, including
17	manholes, main lines, wyes, and tees.
18	(b) Sewer force mains four inches and larger.
19	(c) Water mains four inches and larger, including fire hydrants, valves, and
20	fittings.

AN ACT

l	(2) The provisions of this Subsection shall not pertain to gas mains within
2	the boundary lines of any private property, nor shall they pertain to any service lines.
