AN ACT

To enact R.S. 32:295.4(5), relative to motor vehicle checkpoints; to require certain law enforcement agencies to establish procedures that prohibit checkpoints where the only vehicles subject to or targeted for inspection are motorcycles; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 32:295.4(5) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§295.4. Guidelines for seat belt and motor vehicle liability security checkpoints; law enforcement agencies

All law enforcement agencies involved in traffic enforcement shall establish guidelines for the operation of seat belt checkpoints and proof of compulsory motor vehicle liability security checkpoints. Such guidelines shall include but not be limited to the following provisions:

**(5) Provisions prohibiting the establishment of checkpoints where the only vehicles subject to or targeted for inspection are motorcycles, as defined in R.S. 32:1(38).**
