12	B. The commissioner of agriculture and forestry shall adopt and promulgate		
13	voluntary rules and regulations, consistent with applicable state and federal law, and		
14	the general intent and purpose of this Section, to authorize and promote the		
15	continued use of prescribed burning for ecological, silvicultural, wildlife		
16	management, agricultural, and range management purposes. Such rules and		
17	regulations shall be adopted and promulgated by the commissioner pursuant		
18	to the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act.

20	F. Persons who wish to complain about certain prescribed burns shall		
21	issue their complaints to the commissioner. The commissioner shall investigate		
22	such complaints and have the authority to suspend or revoke his authorization		
23	for the prescribed burn for persons found to be in violation of the prescribed		

1	burn requirements or	rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this
2	Section.
