To commend the University High School boys basketball team upon winning the Class 3A state championship title and to congratulate the Cubs on an outstanding 2013-2014 season.

WHEREAS, the Cubs captured the Class 3A title in a 69-64 victory over Richwood High School at the Louisiana High School Athletic Association-State Farm Boys Top 28 tournament, which is their first state title since 2004; and

WHEREAS, Head Coach Joe Spencer prepared the Cubs by instilling in the team the confidence and skills that are needed for continued success in the future; and

WHEREAS, University High School is the first school since 2011 to capture boys and girls state titles in the same season; and
