John Smith (SB 52) Act No. 367

<u>Prior law</u>, applicable to mayor's court generally, authorized the mayor, as presiding officer of the court, to impose court costs not to exceed \$30 for each offense on any defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and further provides that in addition to the court costs authorized by <u>prior law</u>, the mayor, as the presiding officer of the court of the town of Anacoco, may impose additional court costs not to exceed \$20 for each offense on any defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance.

Effective August 1, 2014.
