HOUSE BILL NO. 1265 (Substitute for House Bill No. 438 by Representative Greene)

BY REPRESENTATIVE GREENE

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 40:1379.1.2, relative to special officer's commissions; to provide for the
3 issuance of a special officer commission to railroad police officers; to provide for the
4 conditions relative to the term and effect of the commission; and to provide for
5 related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 40:1379.1.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §1379.1.2. Special officers commission; rail police officers

9 A. The superintendent of state police shall be authorized to issue at his
10 discretion a special officer's commission from the division of state police to any
11 person who is employed by a rail carrier as a rail police officer in accordance with
12 49 U.S.C. 28101.

13 B. A rail police officer issued a special officer's commission shall maintain
14 current certification pursuant to the Council on Peace Officer Standards and
15 Training.

16 C. The superintendent of state police shall be authorized to perform any of
17 the following acts:

18 (1) Determine eligibility to receive a special officer's commission.

19 (2) Revoke any special officer's commission for cause.

20 (3) Require those rail police officers holding special officer's commissions
21 to furnish proof of being bonded.

22 (4) Require submission of any information that is deemed necessary for
23 determining suitability for holding a special officer's commission.

1 D. A special officer's commission issued to a rail police officer pursuant to
2 the provisions of this Section shall be in effect at all times and to the extent of the
3 authority of a certified or commissioned police officer pursuant to the laws of this
4 state for the purpose of enforcing the laws in any jurisdiction in which the rail carrier
5 owns property and provides protection for the following:

6 (1) Employees, passengers, or patrons of the rail carrier.

7 (2) Property, equipment, and facilities owned, leased, operated, or
8 maintained by the rail carrier.

9 (3) Property moving in interstate or foreign commerce in the possession of
10 the rail carrier.

11 (4) Personnel, equipment, and material moving by rail that are vital to
12 national defense.

13 E. Special officer commissions issued pursuant to the provisions of this
14 Section shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of their issuance.

15 F. The Department of Public Safety and Corrections may promulgate and
16 adopt regulations with respect to the issuance of the special officer's commissions
17 for rail police officers.
