7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 33:4305 (B)(4) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	§4305. Domicile; meetings; officers; bonds; depositories; compensation; rate fixing

11	B. * * *
12	(4) Notwithstanding any contrary provision of this Subsection or of any
13	other provision of law, no member of the board of commissioners of
14	Washington Parish Gas Utility District No. 2 shall receive a salary for the
15	performance of his duties as a member. Each member may receive a per diem
16	for each meeting attended, and for each day devoted to the business of the
17	district. The board shall fix the amount of the per diem in an amount not to
18	exceed one hundred dollars per day. A member may be reimbursed for all
19	proper expenses incurred in carrying out the business of the district. The board
20	may fix reasonable additional compensation, commensurate with the additional
21	duties performed, for a member who serves as secretary or treasurer or
22	secretary-treasurer of the board.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana.
