2	To amend and reenact R.S. 23:1514(D)(1), relative to the Incumbent Worker Training
3	Program; to provide for certain third-party training providers; and to provide for
4	related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 23:1514(D)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§1514. Worker training fund; purpose; training programs; eligibility criteria;
8	program administration

10	D.(1)(a) Training shall be done by a third-party training provider selected
11	by the applicants. The training provider selected by an applicant must have a
12	demonstrated history of successful training through its replacement, retention, and
13	satisfaction rates; show collaboration with regard to industry in the development of
14	customized training; and use current industry standards as the basis for programs
15	utilized to train individuals in a targeted industry. Training may be provided by the
16	applicant's employees under limited circumstances as permitted by duly promulgated
17	rules and regulations. Third-party training providers must have a demonstrated
18	history of successful training. No third-party training provider may be an entity
19	whose principal owner is an immediate family member, as defined by the Code of
20	Governmental Ethics, of an individual in a management position with the applicant
21	who has the authority to make decisions regarding a training grant or a business
22	related to the applicant, such as a parent, subsidiary, or partner of the applicant.
23	(b) Nothing herein shall be construed to prohibit a Louisiana college or
24	university from acting as a third-party training provider.
25	(c) Subject to the provisions of Subparagraph (d) of this Paragraph, a
26	Louisiana college or university may subcontract with an out-of-state college or
27	university to provide the actual training pursuant to this Section provided the

SB NO. 207 ENROLLED 1 training takes place on the campus of a Louisiana college or university or on a 2 Louisiana job site. 3 (d)(i) Prior to entering into an agreement with an out-of-state college or 4 university as provided for in Subparagraph (c) of this Paragraph, the Louisiana college or university shall make an inquiry, in writing, to the commissioner of 5 higher education to determine if such third-party training already exists at 6 7 another Louisiana college or university.
