1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 24:14(H) and (K)(1)(a) and (2), relative to confirmation by the
3	Senate; to provide for notice to certain persons not submitted, confirmed or
4	reconfirmed by the Senate; to provide for the time of reconfirmation for persons
5	serving a specific term; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 24:14(H) and (K)(1)(a) and (2) are hereby amended and reenacted
8	to read as follows:
9	§14. Senate confirmations
10	* * *
11	H.(1)(a) In the event a person is not submitted to or is not confirmed by the
12	Senate, or is submitted to the Senate for reconfirmation but not reconfirmed by
13	the Senate pursuant to Subsection K of this Section, and the person attempts to
14	remain in office after being advised by the Senate, through its president, by
15	certified mail, return receipt requested, of his lack of confirmation or
16	reconfirmation, and acts in his official capacity, any action taken by a public body
17	in which such person participates shall be null and void. The Senate, through its
18	president, shall notify any person not submitted to the Senate for confirmation
19	or not confirmed by the Senate and any person submitted to the Senate for
20	reconfirmation but not reconfirmed by the Senate no later than thirty days after
21	the Senate considers confirmations.
22	(b) The Senate, through its president, may bring an action to remove the
23	person from office. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the venue for any
24	such action shall be East Baton Rouge Parish.

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1	(2)(a) In the event a person is not submitted to the Senate for
2	reconfirmation, pursuant to Subsection K of this Section, and the person
3	attempts to remain in office after being advised by his appointing official by
4	<u>certified mail, return receipt requested, of his failure to be submitted and to be</u>
5	reconfirmed and acts in his official capacity, any action taken by a public body
6	in which such person participates shall be a relative nullity and shall be subject
7	to challenge in district court. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary,
8	the venue for any such action shall be East Baton Rouge Parish.
9	(b) The appointing official shall notify any person whom he failed to
10	submit to the Senate for reconfirmation or who was not reconfirmed and the
11	office, board, commission, committee, or district to which the person was
12	appointed, no later than thirty days after the Senate considers confirmations.
13	* * *
14	K. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all persons who are appointed
15	to a position on a board, commission, committee, or district, which requires Senate
16	confirmation, including persons appointed to a partial term shall be subject to
17	reconfirmation as follows:
18	(1)(a) All <u>The service of each</u> appointees appointed to a term concurrent
19	with the appointing official or at the pleasure of the appointing official shall expire
20	at the end of the appointing official's term as provided for in Article IV, Section 3 of
21	the Constitution of Louisiana or as otherwise provided for by law.
22	* * *
23	(2)(a) All <u>The service of each</u> appointees appointed to a fixed term shall
24	expire at the end of the term to which the appointee was appointed.
25	(b) The appointee may continue to serve until the end of the second regular
26	session of the Legislature following the beginning of the legislative term at which
27	time the position shall become vacant unless the appointee is reappointed to the
28	position and has been confirmed by the Senate by the end of the second regular
29	legislative session expiration of the term.
30	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not

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- 1 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
- 2 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

- 4 effective on the day following such approval.
