Existing law requires a final judgment in district court to be signed by the judge.

Existing law requires a judgment in parish or city court to be signed by the judge.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and requires the judgment to contain the typewritten or printed name of the judge rendering the judgment.

<u>New law</u> prohibits the invalidation of a judgment that does not contain the typewritten or printed name of the judge.

Effective August 1, 2014.
