

Prior law provided that the continuing education requirements for licensed insurance producers did not apply to any person who was a member of the legislature while serving his term.

New law requires that the commissioner grant 24 continuing education credits to licensed producers serving a term in the legislature.

New law authorizes the commissioner to grant continuing education credits to licensed producers who participate in qualified graduate-level national designation programs or are active participants in a state or national insurance association.

New law makes technical corrections in citation.
