Edwards (HB 96) Act No. 875

<u>Present constitution</u> provides that a judge shall not remain in office beyond his 70th birthday and provides that a judge who attains the age of 70 while serving a term of office shall be allowed to complete that term of office.

Proposed constitutional amendment deletes this language.

Provides for submission of the <u>proposed constitutional amendment</u> to the voters at the statewide election to be held on Nov. 4, 2014.
