Garofalo (HB 967) Act No. 562

<u>New law</u> provides that only an international driver's license issued in the foreign individual's country of origin and issued in accordance with the applicable treaty can be a valid noncommercial driver's license in this state.

<u>New law</u> prohibits operating a commercial motor vehicle with an international driver's license.

<u>New law</u> prohibits any person from issuing an international driver's license in this state for use in this state or any other state or territory of the U.S.

<u>New law</u> authorizes the office of motor vehicles to issue a cease and desist order to any person or business issuing an international driver's license in violation of <u>proposed law</u> and provides for procedures for issuing and enforcing such cease and desist orders.

<u>New law</u> authorizes the department to promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement and enforce <u>new law</u>.
