**Abstract:** Removes the collection and transportation of solid waste exception from intentional and simple littering.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the intentional and simple disposal of litter and prohibits allowing the disposal of litter on public or private property or on the waters of the state.

<u>Present law</u> provides for an exception from the intentional and simple littering prohibitions for duly licensed and properly covered commercial vehicles in the course of collecting and transporting solid wastes.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the exception in <u>present law</u>.
