Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER: Provides for a maximum amount to be wagered on a hand of video poker

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 27:410, relative to video draw poker devices; to provide with  
3 respect to the amount of money which can be played on a hand of video draw poker;  
4 and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 27:410 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §410. Limitation on amount of money played and value of prizes

8 A device may not allow more than four dollars to be placed on a game hand  
9 or award credits in excess of the value of one thousand dollars. At establishments  
10 where live racing is conducted, as defined by R.S. 4:211(5), and pari-mutuel  
11 wagering is offered a device may not allow for credits in excess of the value of one  
12 thousand dollars.

**Abstract:** Provides that a video draw poker device may not allow more than \$4 to be placed on a hand of video poker.

Present law provides that a video draw poker device may not allow more than \$4 to be placed on a game, award games, or credits in excess of the value of \$1,000.

Proposed law changes present law to provide that not more than \$4 may be placed on a hand and otherwise retains present law.
