1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To commend the members of the Louisiana State Conference of the Knights of Peter Claver

3 and Ladies Auxiliary and to designate Friday, April 24, 2015, as Louisiana Knights

4 and Ladies of Peter Claver Day.

10 oldest black Catholic organization in the United States; and

11 WHEREAS, the Knights and Ladies of Peter Claver in the state of Louisiana have

12 rendered service to their churches and communities for more than one hundred years; and

13 WHEREAS, the more than seven hundred officers, delegates, and visitors to the

14 Louisiana State Conference of the Knights of Peter Claver and Ladies Auxiliary are

15 convening in the capital city of Baton Rouge for the Seventy-First Annual Conference; and

16 WHEREAS, the continued service of the members of the Louisiana State Conference

17 of the Knights of Peter Claver and Ladies Auxiliary merits sincere commendation and

18 recognition.

19 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby

20 commend the members of the Louisiana State Conference of the Knights of Peter Claver and

21 Ladies Auxiliary upon the celebration of the Seventy-First Annual Conference and does

1 hereby commend these exceptional men and women for their continued service and
2 commitment to the state of Louisiana.
