- "E. Upon motion of the defendant or upon its own motion, if the court
 determines that any action alleging an act of terrorism is frivolous or
 fraudulent, the court shall award costs of court, reasonable attorney fees, and
 any other related costs to the defendant and any other sanctions and relief
 requested pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Article 863."
