Proposed law establishes a microdistillery permit for holders of a Retailer's Class A for an annual fee of \$1,000 which

authorizes the distilling, making, blending, rectifying or processing of any alcoholic beverage in the state. Quantity is limited to 12,000 gallons per year for retail consumption on or off the licensed premises. The permit holder is allowed to sell the beverage himself at retail but not through wholesale or other retail means. The beverage must be taxed in the same manner and rate as other alcoholic beverages.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The bill is expected to generate a minimal amount of self-generated revenue for the Office of Alcohol and Tobacco Control to the extent that microdistilleries obtain the permit created by this bill. The revenue would be generated at a rate of \$1,000 annually per permit holder, the permit fee authorized in the bill. It is uncertain how many microdistilleries will apply for the permit annually.
